Arrival & Dismissal

Parents, to help your child achieve academic success, it is very important that your child attend school each day. Your child should arrive on time and be prepared to start their school day. Students are encouraged to remain in school for a full day of learning.

Student Arrival

- Students in the pre-k classroom enter through the front door at 8:45am and must be signed in by an adult.
- All students in grades K-5 will enter school through the Gym beginning at 8:30am. This door will close at 9:00am.
- Students will be escorted to their classroom by their homeroom teacher.
- Students will be marked tardy after 9:00am. If your child arrives after 9:00am, they must enter school through the front doors and parents are required to sign them into school.

Dismissal

- Students will be dismissed at 3:45pm.
- If your child needs to leave school early, the parent/guardian or designee should report to the front office before 2:45pm. Your child will be called to the front office for an early dismissal.
- Parents are not permitted to go directly to their child's classroom.
- Students will not be permitted to leave school grounds with an adult that's not listed on their child's application or emergency contact list. Absence Procedures

Excessive Absences

- After three (3) days of cumulative unexcused absences, a warning letter will be mailed home.
- After five (5) days of cumulative unexcused absences, a letter will be mailed home and a parent conference will be scheduled at the school.
- After ten (10) days of cumulative unexcused absences, the truancy department will be notified.
