In order for a student to be eligible to register for an AP course he/she must have received a letter grade **A** in the previous year course. A written recommendation must be obtained from the previous teacher.

Students can opt out of Honors English and take AP English. Student can opt out of Honors Civics and Government to take US Government and Politics AP
AP English is offered in grades 10, 11 and 12.

Dual Enrollment Courses will be held at Chester High School on –site in the evening from 3 pm-6pm. In order to qualify for the DCCC Dual Enrollment students must pass the placement test. Students must have a 3.0 GPA to enroll in DCCC Dual Enrollment.

Students have the option of taking Dual Enrollment English in Grade 11 or 12 in place of Honors English Grade 11 or 12. Students can also take Sociology as an elective during Dual Enrollment.
Dual Enrollment will be offered on –site at Chester High School from 3pm – 6 pm.

Note: All students enrolled in the Prestige Learning Honors Academy must demonstrate good academic attendance, pass courses and maintain a 2.8 and above GPA. Students are required to complete a project-based learning activity each semester. At least 40 hours of Community Service must be completed by graduation.
