ADDENDUM A: BACKGROUND INFORMATION TO INFORM PLAN

Strengths

Meeting or exceeding the statewide PVAAS growth standard in ELA/Literature

Meeting or exceeding the statewide PVAAS growth standard in Mathematics/Algebra

Slight increase in advanced ratings on the state assessment in Mathematics and Science

Progress was made in this category as evidenced from the prior years scores, however due to the COVID-19 pandemic and school closures a larger deficit remains.

Significant growth can be noted in grades Kindergarten and 1 towards at or above level. This is evidenced in the Multiyear comparison review.

Growth (Dibels ELA)can be noted in all grades with significant movement from well below to below as evidenced in the 2023 end of year status report.

Dibels was completed in full for grades Kindergarten through 5 for the entire school year (beginning - mid / end)

Challenges

Career Standards Benchmark is 0%

The percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced on Pennsylvania State Assessments in English Language Arts/Literature is 27.9%.

The percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced on Pennsylvania State Assessments in Mathematics/Algebra is 11.6%.

The percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced on Pennsylvania State Assessments in Science/Biology is 33.3%.

Students proficient or advanced is approximately a 27% deficit from the statewide average.

During the 2021/22 school year ; End of year Dibels assessments were not completed for grades 3,4,5; as a result a multi year comparison could not be done.

There is no flexibility in the Naviance student portal for students who require accommodations and supports.

The Naviance System is not recording the correct grade for all students

Teachers are not adequately trained in the program: The system allows a teacher to go in and manually adjust before the first administration of the Diagnostic. If a student's developmental level is significantly below their chronological grade level we should proactively adjust. Teachers need more training on this tool. The benefit of manually setting the developmental level is the reduction of stress and frustration for the student.

There is not a sufficient amount of data on students with
