ADDENDUM A: BACKGROUND INFORMATION TO INFORM PLAN

In English Language Arts/Literature the All Student Group grew from 12.7% to 17.8% in students scoring proficient or advanced.

In English Language Arts/Literature PVAAS students met and exceeded by 5 points the statewide growth target for the all-student group

In Mathematics/Algebra PVAAS students met and exceeded by 2 points the statewide growth target for the all student group.

Most Notable Observations/Patterns

The needs assessment continues to reveal challenges that we must set out to overcome. The challenges fall in the categories of student achievement, instructional best practices, and student attendance. Our student achievement and growth continues to fail to meet state standards on PSSA and we are not on track to meet the goals identified for 2030. Our needs assessment shows attention must be given to helping students achieve regular attendance in order to benefit from instruction and interventions put in place. Teachers need to continue to collaborate with data and protocols designed to enhance practice and focus on instruction and interventions which target specific learning and result in focused academic achievement and growth goals.

Discussion Point Challenges **Priority for Planning** Based on our needs assessment, we determined that the root cause is that we were not fully .3% of students scored proficient or staffed with math-certified teachers advanced on the Mathematics/Algebra statewide assessments Based on our needs assessment we focused our attention on Reading Comprehension. In our 17.8% of students scored proficient or root cause analysis, we noted that while students can cite evidence, they struggle with advanced in English developing well-constructed analysis of the text. While there are formal text-dependent analysis tasks assigned in classrooms, there is a need to provide consistent formal and Language Arts/Literature informal learning opportunities for students including Close Reading and specific discussion protocols, utilizing high interest and appropriately leveled texts to analyze and think critically statewide in all content areas. assessments
