Scheduling for our Elementary and Intermediate Schools has been completed. Our High School Guidance Counselors are currently in the final stages of reviewing transcripts to ensure that all graduation requirements are being met for our senior students. We understand how important it is for families to have access to this information, and once all schedules are finalized, we will promptly announce their availability. You will be able to view your child's schedule through PowerSchool, and we will also post this update on our website and other communication platforms to keep you informed.

Transportation:

Bus route information will start being distributed within the next few days and all information for both school buses, special education services, and curb-to-curb transportation is being completed in our central office.

Once school begins, our transportation vendor, Chester Elite will notify school administrators of any delays in service greater than 15 minutes for school bus service. Delays for van services, curb-to-curb and special needs services, will be communicated by the assigned vendors for that specific student.

Department of Equitable Learning and Support:

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act ensures that all school-aged children and youth experiencing homelessness have the right to the same free and appropriate public education as their peers.

Our district is committed to providing identified homeless students with the necessary resources. If a student is experiencing homelessness, please contact the school social worker or counselor to complete a McKinney-Vento Referral form, which will then be reviewed by CUSD's Department of Equitable Learning and Support. The department

will work with the school to ensure the student receives the education and resources they need, including food, housing, transportation, and supplies.

Through collaboration, advocacy, and leadership, they are responsible for championing the implementation of a multi-tiered system of support to assist students in gaining access to resources and skills needed to become universally competitive and lifelong learners.
