### QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

<p>Please provide an update on repairs in the schools of the district regarding windows, HVAC, gallery bathrooms and locker rooms.</p>	<p>Window and HVAC upgrades were completed at Main Street with ESSER II funds. The funds were obligated by 9/30/23 and liquidated by 12/30/23. The Windows and HVAC upgrades for CUSA and Toby Farms were obligated in ARP ESSER III. These projects are all scheduled for completion by 8/31/24.</p> <p>Bathroom upgrades were completed at Chester High School, Chester School of the Arts and Mainstreet.</p>
<p>Is the district on target to utilize all the ESSER funds effectively prior to September 1, 2024?</p>	<p>The district is on target to obligate all ESSER expenditures by 9/30/24.</p>
<p>What are the plans to ensure that the building buzzers work as intended?</p>	<p>The district works to resolve all issues around buzzers where necessary. If there is a specific school that you are concerned about, please let us know and we will address it.</p>
<p>Has anyone analyzed Edgmont Scholars Academy students from when the school was Widener Partnership Charter to Edgmont Scholars Academy for the remaining students to see if there was data research growth or learning loss among students?</p>	<p>Yes, we have monitored growth and achievement of students at ESA using the available data. Some data, such as previous iReady diagnostic information, are not available. The district has purchased a data platform, Panorama, to easily monitor student performance by assessment.</p>
<p>Has anyone analyzed the data for students who have transferred in from other public schools to look at learning compared to those from ESA?</p>	<p>The district monitors student growth and achievement regularly. The district does not always receive state testing data from the sending LEA, and in those moments, it is difficult to compare achievement and growth.</p>
