QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

How do regular education students access school counselors and other supports when they are in the moment in the classroom.

Regular education students typically access school counselors and other supports through a variety of mechanisms when they are upset in the classroom such as Teacher Referral, Student Self-Referral, Pre-Arranged Appointments, and Counselor (staff Availability). Students are not permitted to walk out of class without permission. They are expected to request permission, obtain a hall pass, and go directly to the counselor. Building administrators and staff are expected to communicate the specific procedures for their building as they can vary depending on the age of the students and available resources.
